



The Diabetes Specialty Clinic has established the following standardized criteria for referrals. To avoid delay in appointment scheduling, please ensure that all supporting information for the pre-determined outcome and/or condition is included with the Outpatient Referral Form **prior** to requesting the referral. Please mark the appropriate box(s) as indicated.

CRITERIA FOR DIABETIC CLINIC DM TYPE I REFERRALS: The Diabetes Specialty Clinic evaluates and treats patients with a hemoglobin A1C of 8% or greater despite multiple drug therapy, all young adults with DM TYPE I and pregnancy with DM. It is encouraged that all patients be referred to Diabetic Education class.

The results of the studies must be included with the referral request.

REQUESTED WORK-UP:

A. It is the referring provider's responsibility to order the labs to be completed within the last three (3) months and submit results with the referral request.

1. Hemoglobin A1C
2. Lipid Panel
3. TSH
4. Chem Panel
5. Spot Urine Microalbumin/Creatinine ratio
